## INSTRUCTIONS

Note: All GEMDUOs should be added with the faceted side faceup and Cabochons with the dome faceup. A shorter segment of the bracelet is shown for illustration clarity.

1. Strip 1: a) On 2yd of thread, add A-Left, D, two C, D, leaving a 5 " tail. Pass through the open hole of the A. b) Add A-Right, D, A-Right, C; pass back through the same holes of the last three beads added and the nearest hole of the next A. Add three C ; pass through the open hole of the first A added in Step 1b. Add D; pass through the open hole of the next A. c) Repeat Step 1b seventeen times. d) Add three C; pass through the nearest $C$ of the final Step 1b repeat. Set this strip aside.
2. Strip 2: Repeat Step 1, adding and passing through the opposite holes of the A so that this strip mirrors Strip 1.
3. a) Using the working thread from Strip 1, add E, B-Right, E, then pass through the next $C$ on the inside edge of Strip 1; repeat sixteen times. Remove Strip 1's stop bead and tie off the tail thread. Add E, B-Right, E, C; then pass through the nearest hole of the next A, D. b) Add four C; pass through the last $D$ exited. Repeat the thread path of the clasp loop for strength (not shown). Weave through the C, D, and outermost A along the outside edge of Strip 1, exiting the second C added in Step 1d. c) Add four C; pass through the last C exited. Repeat the thread path of the clasp loop for strength (not shown). Tie off this thread only.
4. a) Align the strips side by side faceup. Using the working thread from Strip 2, add E; pass through the open hole of the next B. Add E; pass through the next $C$ on the inside edge of Strip 2. Repeat from the beginning of this step sixteen times. Remove Strip 2's stop bead and tie off the tail thread. Add E, B-Right, $\mathrm{E}, \mathrm{C}$; then pass through the nearest hole of the next A, D. b) Repeat Step 3b and 3c.
5. Use jump rings to attach the clasp to the loops at each end (not shown).

Pay attention to which holes to use when adding or passing through GEMDUOs and Cabochons.

74 GEMDUOs (A)
18 CzechMates ${ }^{\oplus}$ Cabochons (B)
1.5 g TOHO $11^{\circ}$ Rounds (C)
$2 \mathrm{~g} \mathrm{TOHO} 8^{\circ}$ Rounds (D)
$1 \mathrm{TOHO} 11^{\circ}$ Demi Rounds (E)
2 Jump Rings 2-Strand Clasp of Choice TOHO One-G Thread

Bracelet as instructed measures approx. $63 / 4^{\text {" before clasp. }}$ Adjustments to length can be made with each Step 1 b repeat.
